Veterinary Dental Services

Endodontics: Root canals, treatment of fractured teeth, crown reductions and tooth infections.

Periodontics: Treatment of periodontal disease, tooth scaling and polishing, root planning, gingival surgery and guided tissue/bone regeneration.

Orthodontics: Bite evaluations, genetic counseling, and orthodontic treatments.

Restorations: Cast metal crowns, fillings, esthetic bonding, bridges and implants.

Dental Radiology: Diagnose periodontal and endodontic disease, missing or extra teeth/roots, oral tumors, fractures, and TMJ disease.

Oral Surgery: Dental extractions, jaw fractures, palatal defects, oronasal fistulas, oral tumors and dislocated teeth.

Oral Diseases: Oral manifestations of systemic disease, stomatitis, and oral autoimmune disorders.

Estimates
